

What should the Chicago Bears do this offseason



Introduction

Free agency

The Chicago Bears have the most cap space in the NFL at \$98M, which is almost double that of any other team this year. Bears need to hit this offseason, Offensive line, Defensive line, and wide receivers.

Offensive line targets:

1. **Orlando brown jr (Kansas City)** - Played 1133 snaps, he had 6 penalties (tied for 36th in the nfl) and he only allowed 4 sacks (tied for 38th in the nfl)
2. **Mike McGlinchey (49ers)** - played 1036 snaps, he had 10 penalties (tied for 8th in the nfl) and he allowed 6 sacks (tied for 15th in the nfl)

Connor McGovern (Jets) - played 1111 snaps, he had 4 penalties (tied for 18th in the nfl) and he allowed 5 sacks (tied for 3rd in the nfl)

Wide receivers Targets:

1. **Mecole Hardman**- he had 25 catches for 257 yards and 4 touchdowns, he is someone i would bring in on a one-year deal to prove himself, he is also a guy i would bring into mentor guys.

2. **Odell Beckham Jr.** - he has not played pro football in a year because of an ACL tear so he would also sign to a one-year deal and a guy that can mentor.

Defensive line targets:

1. **Javon Hargrave**- he had 33 tackles (19th) and 11 sacks (6th) and 1 forced fumble (8th) he would be an instant impact player on the Bears on that defensive line that needs all the help it can get.
2. **Yannick Ngakoue** -he had 13 tackles (94th) 12 sacks (11th) and 1 forced fumble (27th) he is also another guy that would be an instant impact on a defense that needs all the help it can get.

NFL Draft

The Chicago Bears hold the number 1 overall pick in this year's draft, what should they do? The Bears should trade down to a team that is in need of a quarterback, because quarterback is projected to be the top spot in this

year's draft and the Bears don't need a quarterback because they have 3rd year quarterback Justin Fields.
